Enclosed is the ~~new~~ <sup>completed</sup> survey map of land in Colebrook, New Hampshire belonging to the Parsons estate. This survey was based on information furnished by Mr. Marvin Woodard, Mr. Charles Andrews and a type map of Colebrook produced in 1939 by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Evidence on the ground such as wire and rail fence supported this information and the survey was completed accordingly.

The description of the survey is as follows:

"Starting at a corner post located on the easterly side of South Main Street, then proceeding South 32° East along a wire and rail fence for 2.15 chains, then South 26° East along the wire fence for 1.15 chains, then South 20° East along the wire fence for 4.74 chains to a corner post, then South 30° West along a wire fence for 2.05 chains to a corner post; then South 63° East along a wire fence for 3.37 chains to a corner post; then South 4° West along a wire and rail fence for 11.25 chains to a corner post; then South 63° East along a wire and rail fence for 14.37 chains to a cedar tree; then South 46° East along a wire fence for 5.42 chains; then South 63° East along a wire and rail fence for 36.55 chains to a spruce corner post; then North 27° East along a wire fence for 26.00 chains to a corner post; then South 63° East along a wire and rail fence for 23.00 chains to a cedar tree; then South 27° West along a wire fence for 26.00 chains to a corner post; then North 63° West along a rail fence for 12.15 chains to a corner post; then South 27° West along a wire and rail fence for 25.29 chains to a corner post on the Colebrook-Columbia town line; then North 63° West along the town line for 53.17 chains to a corner post; then North 27° East along an old road and wire fence for 27.26 chains to the cedar tree first listed; then North 27° East, partly along a wire fence, for 19.00 chains to a corner post; then North 63° West along a wire fence for 5.10 chains to a brook; then along the brook and wire fence to a corner post on South Main Street; then South 60° West along South Main Street for 7.53 chains; then South 76° West along South Main Street for 7.00 chains to the starting post.

All corner posts have been set and all lines have been spotted and painted orange except the line running from the starting post to corner post #6 which is painted yellow.
